



Certificate highlights

This seven-week program is intended for executives, boards, and general management who face tough decisions about implementing AI programs in their organizations. Delivered through videos featuring international experts, reading lists, and transcripts, learners will be invited to work on an AI system of their choice and to apply lessons to their chosen systems. The program is designed for six to eight hours of personal study time per week, is mainly asynchronous (self-paced), and successful students will earn a certificate of completion from Emory University.

Learning outcomes

After completing this certificate program, participants will be able to:

- Identify the ethical issues raised by use of AI at their organization and elsewhere
- Prepare an ethical impact assessment of their organization’s use of AI
- Suggest how to align use of AI to the mission and values of their organization
- Prepare to respond to ethical challenges to their organization’s use of AI
